



Main Street Presbyterian Church Sunday School & Bible Class Information for Parents September 2022

We are delighted to begin Sunday School & Bible Class again on Sunday the 11th of September – Doors open at 9.45am and activities will start at 9.50am. On the 11th we will be having some breakfast snacks to begin the year with some tasty treats. Children and Young people will be finished at 10.45am and we would ask that younger children are picked up promptly.

- Children must be of school age to attend Sunday School. If your child is P1 (or older) and attending for the first time, just let Esther know so we have seating and resources ready for your child.
- Sunday the 11th will be 'sign up Sunday'. Please download and fill in a copy of the Multi-Purpose parental consent form. You will find it on the Sunday School page on the Church website. It is really important we have up to date contact and health details every year. You can tick all the organisations your child normally attends. Bring this with you on Sunday the 11th and leave it in the box provided in the vestibule outside the Main Hall. We will have spare copies if you forget. **However, we need to gently remind parents/guardians that these forms are required in order for children & young people to attend.**
- Children and young folks are asked to bring their own Bible every week. Bible Class members sometimes use Bible apps, which are very handy, but we really encourage using a personal copy of the Bible which helps in learning and navigating the books of the Old and New Testament, and highlighting and annotating verses and passages.

P4 – Year 8 Classes	Main Hall @ 9.45am
Year 9 Junior Bible Class	Toast and Drinks in Café Link @ 9.45am, Class in Main Hall @ 10am
Senior Bible Class	Café Link (Toast and Drinks in Café Link @ 9.45am)

- An offering will be taken every week and we would encourage all children and Young People to bring an offering each week to contribute to the work of Sunday School, Bible Class and our Mission partners.
- If a child displays any Covid symptoms (high temperature, new continuous cough, loss of taste or smell), they should not attend and should follow gov. guidelines on self-isolation.
- All other previously required PCI mitigations and measures have been removed, however we will be mindful of 'Hands, Face (Catch it, Kill it, Bin it) Space, Ventilate' practices in Sunday School & Bible Class as appropriate.
